### **3** CA Proposition 65 Statement

Under the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (known as Proposition 65 or "Prop 65"), the State of California created and annually updates a list of chemicals known by the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity (the "Prop 65 List").

Prop 65 requires "clear and reasonable" warnings to be given if, in the course of doing business, a person knowingly and intentionally exposes an individual in California to a chemical on the Prop 65 List. Prop 65 also prohibits knowingly discharging or releasing a chemical on the Prop 65 List such that it is likely to, or will, enter any California drinking water source.

Qorvo reviews its suppliers' certifications, material content data, and confidentially disclosed chemicals and materials information. Based on this third-party information, Qorvo has determined that to the best of its knowledge, its products do not expose any person to any chemical on the Prop 65 List nor are any such chemicals discharged or released into any drinking water source during normal product use. Accordingly, the Prop 65 "clear and reasonable" warnings requirements do not apply to Qorvo products and evaluation kits. As a result, Qorvo products are not required to include warnings specifically related to Prop 65 or the Prop 65 List chemicals. If after review of available material content data Qorvo determines an exposure requiring a Prop 65 warning may exist, Qorvo will provide the necessary warnings.

Qorvo continues to take reasonable steps to acquire representative and accurate data that may in some cases include the use of destructive testing or chemical analysis on incoming materials and chemicals and update its material content data accordingly. Qorvo also updates material content data as new requirements are identified. Qorvo and Qorvo's suppliers may consider certain information to be proprietary and, therefore, CAS numbers and other data may not be available for release.

In order to help its customers meet their obligations under Prop 65, Qorvo is able to provide full material declarations, using the IPC 1752A format. Customers should request material declarations by emailing <u>QorvoGreen@qorvo.com</u>.
